Community Health Centers Report Being More Financially Stable, Better Able to Provide Care in Expansion States

According to the brief, health centers in states that have expanded Medicaid are significantly more likely than health centers in nonexpansion states to report improvements in financial stability (69% vs 41%) since the Affordable Care Act was implemented and are more likely to participate in value-based payment models, such as the patient-centered medical home model.
